29	3.	Temporary Permission to Gilbert Excavating Vehicles for Access Past the Barricade
30		on Lakeside Blvd. to do Critical Seawall Work. Main points of discussion, J. Wilkins
31		asked Leroy Reed to explain the specifics of where the big trucks and CATs will be
32		beyond the barricade on Lakeside Blvd. L. Reed response: "Trucks will come inside
33		the steel I-beam gate and then the steel will have to be transported with the CATs
34 35		down to the job site." "Trucks are not going to be running down the beach, the CATs will be going back and forth transporting the steel." "The Barricade needs to be
36		removed so that the trucks can go down Lakeside Boulevard. We will have 8" steel I-
37		beams for a gate, so it will be gated and locked. It will open for the equipment,
38		brought in for the day and closed. The gate will be closed but it will still allow foot
39		traffic." "There won't be any expense to The Village at all." B. Soper asked how the
40		trucks will travel down Lakeside Blvd. L. Reed response: "The trucks will park just
41		after the barricade (just past the second public access entrance to the beach) and

the CATs will go down to the end of Lakeside Boulevard then it turns into a little bit

of a two-track and actually ends where the water is now, there's no dune in between anymore, so we will actually cross over there, and then we will transverse at the water line where the (Army Corps of Engineers) corps has got us as a travel route by using the riparian rights travel the rest of the way." Discussion on allowing a timeframe for the term temporary. Motion by K. Holmes to grant temporary permission to Gilbert Excavating vehicles for access past the barricade on Lakeside Boulevard to do critical seawall work, tentatively until the end of July (with special circumstances for July 4 to come later). Including permission to remove the barricade and replace it with a locking I-beam gate, to remain locked continuously throughout the day, as trucks move through. Seconded by B. Soper. – Roll Call: K. Holmes, Aye; B. Soper, Aye; J. Wilkins, Aye. Motion Carried.
