County Commissioner - Sauer - Still having difficulty with COVID Vaccines, need more; Numbers are showing the virus is not affecting as many, numbers are dropping, closer to the numbers back in October 2020; Maples waiting for final inspections for the Generator to run the whole building; Vaccines at the Maples - all but 3 patients accepted as well as approximately 50% of staff; Meeting with National Park North Shore... Private enterprise with the funds and ability to do so, looking to do a feasibility study, may be a slow process as the one out west took ~ 6 years; trying to upgrade the boardroom, a system with better speakers, audio, tv screens, with the room to be available to the township such as Planning Commission, trainings and such; Betsie Valley Trail going for bids for the construction from Mollineaux Road into Beulah, have the money from the DNR Trust and the Friends are getting the match going for the 11th of March, need proper path to help keep bikes off the road.
