 - i. On Friday, February 10, 2023, applied for the Federal Safer Grant asking for \$2M for a new ladder truck.
 - 1. If awarded, there may be some matching funds up to \$95K that might have to be contributed.
 - 2. Par-Plan declined (we will reapply next round)
 - 3. Fire House Subs declined (no notification)
 - 4. Band of Ottawa Indians On Friday, February 10, 2023, the Frankfort Fire Department was awarded a grant in the amount of \$7,875.00 to purchase 25 new fire helmets.
 - a. Our 2% matching contribution equates to \$875.00.
 - EGLE 2023 Community Energy Management Program (CEM) Applied for a state grant to replace all the lights and fixtures in the Fire Station with all LED.
