The permittee as well as a water hose or operable fire extinguisher must be on-site during burning. Permit fee is \$20. (Form effective May 17, 2023)

Applicant is responsible for obtaining Fire Chief's approval and signature; Fire Chief completes dates. After Fire Chief approval, applicant signs the form and mails, drops off, or emails it to the Village Office along with fee. A copy of the approved permit will be sent to the address provided. The original will be kept on file at the Village Office.
