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#### **New Business**

1. Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund Grant TF20-0013 Elberta Lake Michigan Beach Improvements Contract Bid Award – AJ's Excavating MIcek described the project: expanded gravel parking (27 spots), regravel of existing lot, new pavilion, plank and mobi mat walkway to pier, concrete sidewalk along edge of parking, additional public beach access, public restroom with flush toilets (involves new well and drainfield). Called for bids in May. Received 4 bids ranging from \$540K to \$1M+; original budget was \$465K. Mlcek and Wilkins secured help from Grand Traverse Regional Land Conservancy (GTRLC); original MNRTF grant was \$300K; GTRLC covered the match portion of \$165K; when all bids came in over budget additional inquiries made for help from Sand Products Corporation and elsewhere; GTRLC came up with balance of funding needed = an additional \$350K. Five references were checked on low bidder and reviews were very poor; MDNR agreed to the rejection of that bid; AJ's is second lowest bidder. Votruba asked about history of project: In the works since at least 2017, before Wilkins was elected president, in 2018; MIcek consulted on project with previous admin; Wilkins did the funding presentation to DNR in application for the grant in 2020. McGregor said project is in line with the Master Plan and Parks Plan. Village will have to cover the cost for the flush toilets; GTRLC would cover vault toilets but not plumbed toilets; that amount is \$105K, which Wilkins said is already budgeted. Road between two parking areas will be widened somewhat and graveled but not paved. GTRLC and MDNR involvement ensures project will be ecologically sound; Mlcek said permitting process was long and involved, with several modifications per feedback from the two entities. Pavilion to be located at end of south parking lot. Timber planks can be put on sand but paved pathway was nixed; per DNR, a permanent walkway would have to be an elevated boardwalk. Votruba asked about timeline and DPW involvement. AJ's wants to begin this fall; projected completion May 2024; DPW involvement minimal, mostly related to restroom construction and access through gate. Towle asked about sewer connection; it will be septic. Fiebing asked about wheelchair access; mobi mat enables this. **Motion** by Holmes, seconded by McGregor, to award the contract bid for the Elberta Lake Michigan Beach Improvements Project to AJ's Excavating. Roll call: Fiebing Aye | Holmes Aye | McGregor Aye | Votruba Aye | Wilkins Aye. All ayes. Motion passed.
