Re: Frankfort Fire & Rescue Department Report for the Month of November/December 2023.

#### I. Administrative

- Fire Department
  - Membership There are currently 27 members on the roster and 2 Cadets
    - 1. On December 6, 2023 a meeting was held with the high school counselor, Ms. Roth, and a Senior who is interested in the Frankfort Firefighter Cadet Program. The required paperwork and parental permissions were previously emailed for review. After meeting with the student, and reviewing her academic and extracurricular schedule, we discussed enrolling her in the hybrid fire academy class starting in January since she is 18.
  - Officers Meeting December 1, 2023.
    - 1. We discussed the future of the drone, and the sheriff's rescue boat.
    - 2. We all agreed that since the next training date is the day after Christmas, we would postpone our December training meeting.
    - 3. Outlined topics such as Safety, Training, Maintenance, Personnel, and the events forthcoming in December were also discussed.

## Fire Advisory Board

 A meeting will be held with the Clerk-Treasure to discuss the 2024-2025 proposed Fire Budget based on the formula. In January the Fire Advisory Board will convene to discuss the proposed budget before each of the township's annual budget reviews and approvals.
