Discussion of bid: Fiebing and McGregor wanted to seek other bids, 12 possibly with other wood sources, given the historical nature of the bld and quest for historic landmark 13 14 status. Motion by McGregor, seconded by Votruba, to table item pending Fiebing check on other 15 options.
