Village of Elberta Submission Authorization of TF25-0007 MNRTF Land Acquisition Grant Application with Donated Funds Match

At the regular meeting of the Elberta Village Council, Benzie County, Michigan, held at the Community Building at 401 First street on March 13, 2025, at 7pm.

The following resolution was offered by Trustee, Emily Votruba, and supported by Trustee, Jennifer Wilkins.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Elberta supports the submission of a Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund (MNRTF) Grant Application titled, "Terminus Park Acquisition TF25-0007" to the Department of Natural Resources MNRTF for acquisition of 16 acres that extends from Elberta Beach to the Historic Waterfront Park, for use as a public park; and,

WHEREAS the proposed application is supported by the Community's 5-Year Approved Recreation Plan; and,

WHEREAS Grand Traverse Regional Land Conservancy is hereby making a financial commitment to the project in the amount of \$5,500,000 matching funds, in cash and,

WHEREAS if the grant is awarded the applicant commits its local match amounts from the following sources:

Total \$5,500,000

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Village of Elberta hereby authorizes submission of a Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund Grant Application for \$5,173,800 and further resolves to make available a local match through financial commitment and donations of \$5,500,000 (51%) of a total \$10,673,800 project cost, during the 2025 - 2026 fiscal year.
