

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

### *Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Village of Elberta*

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During September 1, 2025, to September 30, 2025, we did not monitor for haloacetic acids (HAA5) or Total Trihalomethanes (TTHM) at the approved sampling location and, therefore, cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time. However, this violation **does not** pose a threat to your supply's water.

**What should I do?** There is nothing you need to do at this time. This is not an emergency. You do not need to boil water or use an alternative source of water at this time. Even though this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we are doing to correct the situation.

The table below lists the contaminant samples we did not properly test for, how often we are supposed to sample for these contaminants, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date we will collect follow-up samples.

**What happened? What is being done?** We did not take the DBP during September as required in an EGLE reviewed Disinfectant and Disinfection Byproduct (DBP) Monitoring Plan as required for compliance monitoring. We are doing everything we can to make sure this does not happen again. We will sample at the location required in the Monitoring Plan in September 2026.
