My name is Louis Vinson, and I am a Senior Rural Development Specialist with Great Lakes Community Action Partnership (GLCAP), a member of the Rural Community Assistance Partnership (RCAP) Network www.glcap.org/rcap.

An income survey is used in a community which is not well-represented by the latest census data, either because of the geography served by the utility, or because there is a justifiable reason to that the income is inaccurate. Reasons why an entity would want to conduct an income survey: Economic fluctuation in the community; The entity is not an entire Village; and Census for the Village does not represent the service area. The community responses will be held in the strictest confidence. As the third-party we will calculate an average income for the Village to apply for the appropriate funding opportunities.
